





Where does my money go?

In the classification task we asked subjects to rate morphs at different morph levels as "humans" or "monkeys".

RESULTS


Subjects rated morphs as humans when the faces had a contribution of at least 65 % human (35% monkey).



We asked subjects whether subjects could distinguish between successively presented morphs differing by 20% morph-level along the continuum. We measure subject's sensitivity (d*) to detect species differences along the human-monkey continuum. We assume that the morph level which elicits a maximal sensitivity represents the category boundary.

RESULTS

We found that the category boundary was set at 67% of human (33% monkey).




INFERING PERCEPTION FROM MONEY BRAIN SIGNALS


Experiment Design

Monkeys fixate at face images rendered. from 3D face models. which are linear interpolations between human and monkey faces. (figure on the right). While monkeys fixate at those faces, extracellular brain signals are recorded.

Based on these signals and using pattern classifier algorithms and information theory. we decode what the animal is perceiving. in other words, we try to infer the category of the presented faces.




Classification of the neural responses



Decoding the human/monkey category boundary of monkeys M1 (left) and M2 (right) using the neural population activity of single cells in the inferior temporal cortex. Responses of the pattern classifier trained with monkey vs. human faces (3/4 of the data at 100% vs. 0% morph level) to test faces. Dot symbols represent classifier responses on each iteration, curves represent associated psychometric function fits. Red vertical arrows mark the category boundary, which was shifted away from the center of the continuum towards the monkey side.

Category information transmission of face-cells



Discriminability between adjacent pairs of morphs by face-selective neurons of monkeys M1 (left) and M2 (right). The category boundary stimated from the enural responses is situated at the point of maximal discriminability along the continuum. Mutual information (bits/s) carried about morph pairs: 0% vs 20%, 20% vs.40%, 40% vs.60%, 60% vs.80%, and 80% vs. 100% (horizontal axis). The category boundary estimated from the face-selective single neurons is shifted towards the monkey side.

CONCLUSIONS

- Our results are the first to demonstrate the neural basis of categorical representation of a facial attribute.
- The shift in the category boundary could be a neural signature to indicate specialized processing of categories with higher behavioral relevance
- Having control of the physical-similarity between faces, we showed that: Categorization of species depends on the species of the observer. We suspect that other important face attributes, like race, gender or mood, could be represented simultaneously by large networks in the temporal lobe.




